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KASPERIA

Kasperia is an ancient name of Kashmir given by the Greeks. We chose this name to present our first ever Kashmiri bridal collection to connect our work with the rich heritage and roots.

The name from the bygone era is given to a collection that upholds a significant part of Kashmiri art and culture.

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CERULEAN MAJESTY

This teal blue lehenga with Aari embroidery (both multi colour and self), hand cut dana and sequence highlighting is ready to dazzle on big days like weddings. The paisley floral patterns that run through the lower layer add a magical touch that reflect the essence of luxury.







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NEELAHAT

The blue skies, the clouds with a silver tint, the essence of Kashmir, and its freshness, all came together while we imagined this royal kurta, which was materialised by skilled hands. The antique Tilla embroidery crafted at the hems radiate luxury and rarity while complementing the bluish-silver tone.





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ROYAL RADIANCE

Delicate blooms, rendered in contrasting hues, weave their way across the pure raw silk, their beauty accentuated by swirling paisley patterns. But this floral dance takes a more mysterious turn with the incorporation of darker elements. This subtle tension between light and dark, between floral charm and captivating mystery, imbues the gown with an air of royalty unlike any other.





PAISLEY MAJESTY

This silk sherwani boasts a captivating paisley print, its swirling teardrop shapes dancing across the smooth silk surface. The true magic unfolds with the Kashmiri embroidery, meticulously hand-stitched by artisans. The sheen of the silk creates a sophisticated air, while the paisley and Kashmiri embroidery add a touch of ethnic flair. The perfect choice for weddings or any grand event; walk as a reflection of royalty.







GULAB'S WHISPER

A floral pattern runs through this elegant kurti flaunting Aari threads and Tilla work. The star of the show lies in the breathtaking floral embroidery that adorns the kurti. Inspired by the stunning blooms of Kashmir, delicate and blossoming vines are meticulously hand-stitched in shades of rose, fuchsia, and a touch of wild flowers.





MAHARAJA'S BAGH

Delicate threads, imbued with the stories of generations past, are meticulously hand-stitched onto the sherwani. The floral designs cascading down the sherwani or adorning the cuffs and collar, these blooms could be vibrant and colorful, reminiscent of a spring garden, creating a sense of understated elegance.





MAHARANI'S RESHAM

This lehenga is a vision of regal elegance, a Kashmiri heritage. The base of the garment is a luxurious silk, its rich sheen catching the light with every movement. Aari embroidery, with its meticulous chain stitch technique, dances across the surface in a symphony of vibrant colours. The antique Tilla embroidery is ready to complement the gold and diamond jewellery on a bride.







WAER -E- NOOR

Zari embroidery dances across the surface, catching the light with a symphony of threads; Waer-e-Noor translates to 'Veil of Light'. This is more than a garment; it's part of history that has been carried forward by skilled hands, preserved and honoured by Angad Creations.







BALHIAN-E-SHAAN

A set that brings back memoirs from the past as it gives the groom a look of a Maharajas, Balhian-e-Shaan translates to 'Attire of Grandeur'. The elegant Tilla work dates back to centuries and has been honed by skilled hands that have left no stone unturned to add the essence of an ancient era to this masterpiece.



ZAHGEER

The embroidery work known as Aari, graces the hem and gives the kurta a rich feel as the high quality silk shines throughout its body. The lustrous look is perfect for attending weddings, festivities, and traditional events.







KHUSRAWI SHAAAN

TILLA HERITAGE TYE-DYE SAREE

The rust and green silk saree, the colour of green Earth, would gracefully drape around a bride. The silk velvet cape adds to the elegance of the look with the antique Tilla embroidery. 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SHALIMAR'S DUSK

WAZWAN -E- SAFED

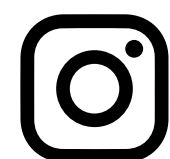
